- Please send me the press tickets (and purchase tickets) by post in advance. I will pay a flat rate of 10.00 euros for postage and packing.

## Press and purchase tickets

Press tickets in conjunction with purchase tickets will generally be sent by post in advance for a flat-rate postage fee of 10.00 euros. The tickets will be sent after receipt of payment.

## Important notes

1. We reserve a maximum of one free press ticket per event for each member of the press. For certain events of the Handel Festival, only purchase tickets are available for journalists.
2. Please note clearly if you would like to purchase additional purchase tickets and also indicate the corresponding price group. If tickets in one price group are already sold out, we will book the purchase ticket in another category. There is no entitlement to purchase tickets. However, we will make every effort to fulfil all requests.
3. After receipt of the accreditation we will send you a confirmation e-Mail about realisable ticket requests from April 2024.
4. For events that are already sold out, there is no longer any entitlement to a purchase or press ticket after the re-registration date has expired.
5. In the interest of other festival visitors, please cancel in good time at the press department of the Handel House if you are unable to attend events already booked for which you have received a press ticket. The exchange and return of already purchased tickets is excluded.
